

Duck Tape Can Do Anything

You can make almost anything out of Duct Tape, and it turns out that it makes pretty spectacular trick or treat bags. Keep it simple with jaw dropping monsters, or go the detailed route with a haunted house or just go with the classic, spooky skeleton.

Approximate Crafting Time: 0:25

Supplies and Tools:

Duck Tape®

Scissors or craft knife

Crafting board

Step 1

Make 2 Duck Tape® fabrics by laying strips of tape, sticky side up, next to each strip so it slightly overlaps the other. Continue until you have the size you want for your bag.

Step 2

Take it and turn it sideways so the strips are going left to right. Lay the next strips, sticky side down, going up and down so it is laying the opposite direction.

Step 3

To assemble the bag, place the 2 fabrics on top of each other.

Step 4

Attach the 2 overlapping fabrics together by placing a strip of Duck Tape® down the sides and bottom (leave the top open)

Step 5

For your straps, make 2 double sided strips of Duck Tape® by folding each strip sticky side to sticky side.

Step 6

Attach both straps to the top of your tote with small strips of tape on the inside.
